



Rules of conduct for students for the participation in attendance examinations at the TU Clausthal during the Corona Pandemic

- The 3G-rule is required in all buildings of the TU Clausthal. The current access restrictions can be found [here](#).
- All participants in an attendance examination are required to submit a current (PoC antigen rapid test 24 hrs; PCR test 48 hrs), official certificate of a negative test result. Only persons who can prove booster vaccination or recovery after complete vaccination ("breakthrough infection") are exempt.
A test possibility on site before the beginning of the examination does not exist in principle. A self-conducted quick test is not sufficient.

- Persons who have been infected with Covid-19, are suffering from Covid-19-symptoms (esp. fever, sore throat, cough and/or smell/taste disorder), have tested positive for the Corona virus (self-test or PCR-test) or are in officially ordered quarantine are not allowed to enter the university and are not allowed to participate in any examination. - General hygiene measures ([here](#)) must always be followed.
- Participants in an attendance examination are required to wear a mask (med. or FFP2-/KN95-mask), at all times. It is strongly recommended to wear a FFP2-/KN95 mask. Masks may only be removed shortly to drink.
- Students unable to wear a mask for medical reasons should contact the responsible examiner in advance (no later than 1 week before the exam) and submit a medical certificate.
- Students of a risk group are required to contact the responsible examiner at least 3 days prior to the exam.
- Please check Stud.IP for the exact starting of your respective exam.
- You will be informed about the entrance to the examination room in advance. There will be designated waiting areas with sufficient safety distance.
- The examination room must be entered individually. Please make sure to be at the examination room in time.
- At the entrance to the examination room please disinfect your hands at the disinfection station. Then proceed to the identity check and 3G check. For meetings at Clausthal University of Technology contact tracking is legally required according to § 6 para. 4 of the Lower Saxony Corona Ordinance (QR code / contact tracking list).
- Please indicate any change of your contact details (address, telephone no.) prior to the examination.
- The examiners will announce how to leave the room at the end of the examination.
